<b>6. Description of content:</b> Revision of the Mandatory Standard SI 900 part 2.11, dealing with tumble dryers, to be replaced with SI 60335 part 2.11. This proposed standard revision adopts the International Standard IEC 60335-2-11 – Edition 8.0: 2019-04, with a few changes that appear in the standard's Hebrew section. The major difference between the old version and this new revised draft standard is the removal of the national paragraph 203 dealing with the noise level.  Both the old and the new revised standards will apply from entry into force of this revision for a transition period of 12 months. During this time, products may be tested according to the old or the new revised standard.
<b>7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:</b> Protection of human health or safety; Harmonization; Reducing trade barriers and facilitating trade
